The project included:

- Demolition works—existing walls, floors tiles, showers, fixtures and fittings
- Installation and general works
 - Bedding and waterproofing, new vinyl floors, tiled walls, laminate toilet partitions, bench seats
 - All new female and male showers, toilets, urinals and privacy screens
 - Glazing/mirrors, skylights, LED lighting and exhaust fans
 - New security doors
 - Paint internal/external and painting existing screens at toilet block
 - New water isolation valves to block 21
- Repair works including childcare roof repairs and repairs from white ant damage, including wall removal and making good

The St Augustine Catholic College community were delivered a new amenities facility during the school holidays; ensuring the school programme, especially during the busy return-to-school period, was seamlessly maintained.
